APPLICATION FOR A BACHELOR'S DEGREE – GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. A total of 45 course units (48-56 course units in Music) is required for graduation from the Weinberg College of Arts and Sciences and Communication. The last 23 courses (minimum 24 courses in Music) must be taken while enrolled as an undergraduate at Northwestern University, and the last three quarters must be taken at NU while registered as a student in the school granting the degree.

In addition to and independent of the above regulations established by the faculties of the respective schools, the University Enrollment Requirement states that all students must complete 12 full time academic year quarters or the equivalent. Consult the Financial Regulations section of the Undergraduate Catalog for further information.

2. MONTH: Indicate month of degree completion (December, March, June, or August) and year.
3. UNDERGRADUATE CATALOG: Indicate catalog by year (e.g., 2005).
4. SCHOOL (check ONLY one; if dual major within or outside your school, then use separate forms for each major):
 - WCAS: Indicate your MAJOR and SUBGROUP, if applicable (e.g., CHEMISTRY major, Biochemistry Emphasis); NOTE: not more than 11 quarters of credit taken in EDUCATION, ENGINEERING, JOURNALISM, MUSIC, and COMMUNICATION may be counted toward a WCAS degree.
 - MUSIC: Indicate your MAJOR and principle INSTRUMENT.
 - COMMUNICATION: Indicate your MAJOR; if COMMUNICATION STUDIES, then indicate the FIELD OF CONCENTRATION (F.O.C.).

6. MAJOR REQUIREMENTS: List ONLY those major courses yet to be completed; if specific course is unknown, indicate general category (e.g., 1 3-level ENG), and CHECK the quarter you intend to complete each entry. Major requirements within each school are defined below:
 - WCAS: As detailed in the undergraduate catalog.
 - MUSIC: As Music Basic Studies and Specialization courses.
 - COMMUNICATION: As detailed in the undergraduate catalog.
7. RELATED COURSES: List all related courses completed, yet to be completed; if specific course is unknown, indicate general category (e.g., 1 3-level HIST), and CHECK the quarter you intend to complete each entry. Related Courses within each school are defined below:
 - WCAS: As detailed in the undergraduate catalog – List ALL courses, completed and yet to be completed.
 - MUSIC: Disregard this space.
 - COMMUNICATION: As required courses outside Communication – Communication Studies majors should list those Field of Concentration courses.
