

**Summary of the Double-Counting Rules for Majors and Minors in WCAS**  
**This table shows rules from the 2017-18 Undergraduate Catalog. Other rules may apply for other years.**

\* As a general rule, courses used to fulfill WCAS **distribution requirements** may double-count toward a WCAS major's "department/program" courses or its related courses. They may also double-count toward the requirements for a WCAS minor.  
 \* **Related courses** for a WCAS major may double-count with another WCAS major's "department/program" or related courses and/or with courses required for a WCAS minor.

\* In general, department/program courses for a major may not be double-counted toward a minor, but a few minors are exceptions to this rule. Please refer to the bottom of this table for a list of minors allowing double counting.

\* A course cannot double-count toward requirements for two WCAS minors.
